### Reading Challenge Rules

**Read to earn prizes at 180, 420, & 900 minutes. For every 30 minutes you read, you also earn 1 ticket for big prize drawings.** The big prize packs are on display. Put tickets in the jars next to the prize packs you want to win. You can claim level prizes and tickets as often as you want- just don't wait until the last minute. All small prizes and tickets must be claimed before July 25th.

**We ask that any book you read for the program be checked out from the library.**

Checking out library items boosts our statistics, which directly affects our funding. Thanks!  
ALL kinds of library books can count: Books on CD, downloadable eBooks and audiobooks, and Wonderbooks.  
Books that kids and parents read together count for both of you!  
If you're reading on your own, please read books at or above your level.

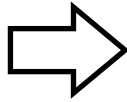

Mark off each 30 minutes you read from June 8th through July 25th.

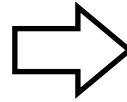
**Books must be checked out or downloaded from the library.**
